LAS VEGAS - February 2, 2012 - Clinical psychologist and neuropsychologist Danielle T. Bello, Ph.D., has joined Cure 4 The Kids Foundation effective February 1, 2015.

Dr. Bello will become the foundation's first full-time, in-house licensed psychologist and neuropsychologist providing services to patients of The Children's Specialty Center of Nevada and The Hemophilia Treatment Center of Nevada.

Dr. Bello also fulfills the mission of Cure 4 The Kids Foundation to bring an ever increasing variety of pediatric and adolescent medical experts to patients in one location.

"I am very excited to be joining this impressive team of individuals working to serve children's needs in this community," said Danielle T. Bello. "I see so much potential for growth. Neuropsychological services will really improve patient care and quality of life from both a cognitive and emotional standpoint."

Previously, Dr. Bello worked in Las Vegas in private practice. She received her Doctorate of Philosophy in Clinical Psychology from the University of Las Vegas in 2009. She completed her Master of Arts in Psychology at New York University where she graduated with honors in 2003 and completed her undergraduate work at Binghamton University in 1997. Bello was the recipient of six research and fellowship grants.

"Dr. Bello is not only a talented clinician, but will be a wonderful and needed resource for many of our patients, said Annette Logan, President and CEO of Cure 4 The Kids Foundation. "Those patients who undergo chemotherapy, specifically, will find her skills extremely helpful as the treatment can create changes in how a child thinks and ultimately learns."

Bernstein saw firsthand the difficulties faced by families whose children were affected by major diseases but didn't have the financial resources or health insurance to receive treatment.
